



















13-Month Rolling Workload and Allocation of Work















Field Services Organization Chart

Operations Center Update

Central Dispatch

Centralizing planners and dispatchers improved communication and coordination among team leaders and technicians.

The new setup enabled quicker response times during emergencies through better coordination.

Plan to add sensors, advanced metering and software, so that the operations centers can perform real-time data analysis to monitor the performance of all system components





Operations Center Update



Prioritization of Work Activities

Work order prioritizations are now automatically set based on risk model LOF/COF including the following criteria:

- Service Level Agreement (SLA) date.
- Identification in High Priority polygon
- A lower prioritization may increase in priority if past SLA date.
- Manual adjustments may be done by Staff due to mitigating circumstances.



Fire Hydrant Update



- 29,881 Fire Hydrants Inspected by DFD Between
 October and February
- Current: Out of Service Hydrants > 1% (124/29,881)
