- Continuing to work with operations on ensuring team safety practices relative to illness prevention(COVID-19 Health Screening)

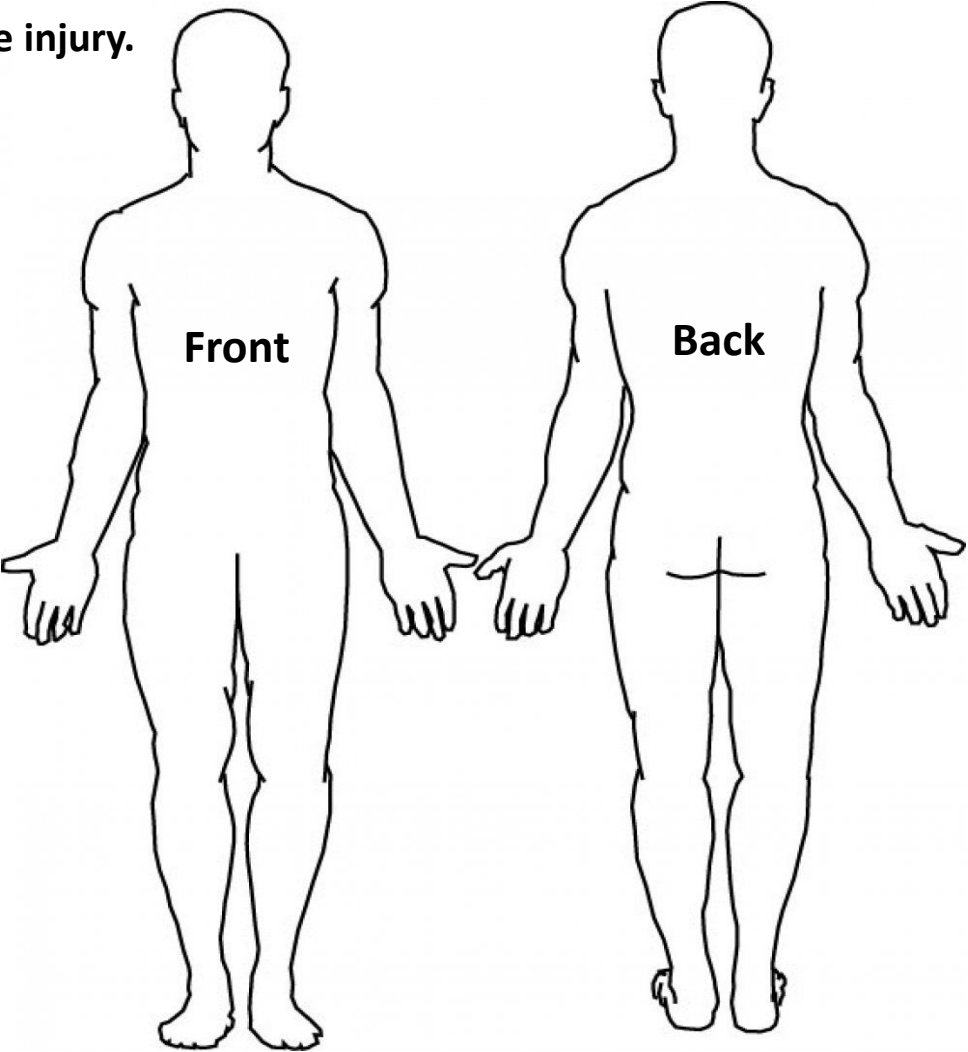
2. Communication of Preventative Measures to limit the spread of illness

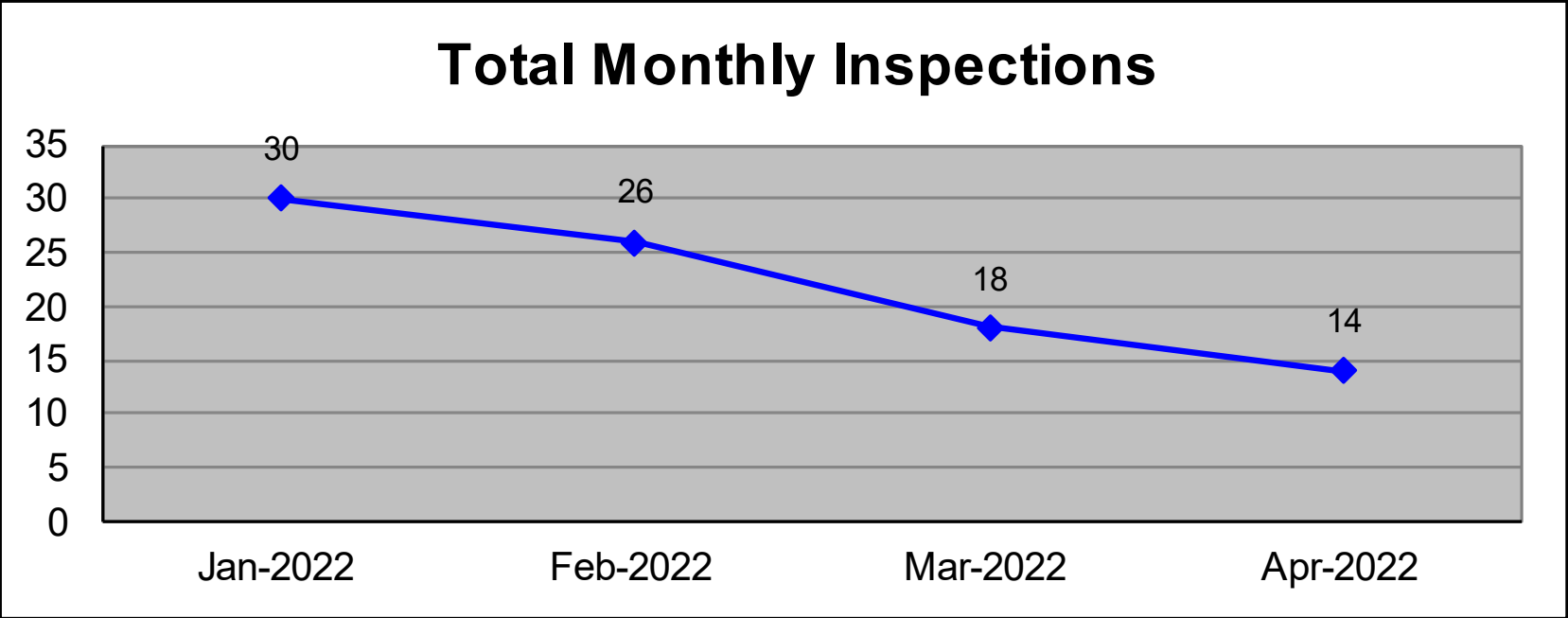
