No matter the format of the records, the Center does not authorize DWSD to take any action that would cause the Center to incur costs related to this request without the Center's express written authorization.

#### **Records Requested**

Request No. 1:

Any and all documents compiled or prepared by DWSD in order to complete a materials evaluation of the distribution system to identify a pool of targeted sampling sites pursuant to Mich. Admin. Code R. 325.10710a(1)(a).

Request No. 2:

Any other compilation of documents prepared by DWSD pursuant to Mich. Admin. Code R. 325.10710a(1)(b), including the following: (i) all plumbing codes, permits, and records in the files of the building department or departments that indicate the plumbing materials installed within publicly and privately owned structures connected to the distribution system; (ii) all inspections and records of the distribution system that indicate the material composition of the service connections connecting a structure to the distribution system; (iii) all existing water quality information that indicates locations which may be particularly susceptible to high lead concentrations.
