The Board of Water Commissioners for the City of Detroit, Water and Sewerage Department authorizes the Director to approve Amendment 1 to DWSD Contract 6002993 (CS-1939) with AssetWorks LLC for Fleet and Fuel Management Software by requesting to add funding in the amount of \$374,483.77, for a new total amended contract amount of \$571,995.23; and to extend the term by 5 years, through 9/30/28. This also authorizes the Director to take such other action as may be necessary to accomplish the intent of this vote.
