

WHERE'S YOUR LINE?

Most of the City's water mains are in the front of a property. Mains are typically located under the street or under the grass between the sidewalk and street (the right of way).

WHO WILL FIX IT?

Property owners are responsible for the water service line from the water meter to the curbstop (turn-on/turn-off valve) near the sidewalk. DWSD is responsible for the portion from the curbstop to the water main.

LEAD WATER LINE?

If your water service line is lead, it will be replaced from the meter in your house to the water main. This is done when the water main on your street is replaced or DWSD is in your neighborhood doing lead service line replacements.

DON'T HAVE A LINE?

*If the water service line does not exist or is not connected, you may be responsible for hiring a plumber and pulling permits to have a new water service line installed from the City's water main to the house.
