
Covid-19 Safety Update – Illness Communication

2 Communication of Preventative Measures to illness spread


- Working with Public Affairs on DWSD/COD Covid-19 branding requirements
- Requiring sick employees to stay at home and undergo COVID testing before returning to work, minimum of 5-days off. Returning to work is contingent of negative test results.
- Individual who is positive and may have exposed a co-worker, the co-worker should be tested. The co-worker is to quarantine for 72-hours ,then test and with negative results may return to work.
- Washing hands more frequently, encouraging mask wearing with the uprise of illness this season with, i.e., COVID-19, Flu and RSV (respiratory syncytial virus)


