NATIONAL EXECUTIVE SURVEY: Determines the basic objectives of the organizational unit; formulates plans and policies and allocates resources for the achievement of these objectives. Interprets and applies policies established by the owners of the enterprise or their representatives (Bd. of Directors, Trustees, etc.). Organizes the unit and determines allocation of duties and authorities to subordinates. Exercises controls to see that objectives are achieved in accordance with basic organization policy. Fully accountable for the results of the activity of the organizational unit. This is usually a single incumbent position.

ERI: Plans, develops, establishes, and oversees interpretation and implementation of policies and objectives of organization in accordance with board directives and corporation charter. Responsible for the profitability of the entire organization. Holds position of the top executive and principal organization leader in the organization. This position is distinguished from others in that it is the top ranking executive and, in most cases, is the highest paid executive in the organization.
