The DWSD does not have access to customers' health information and we cannot respond to your questions regarding service interruptions and the coronavirus pandemic.

The City has not implemented water stations because the results of the Water Restart Plan indicate we have reached all households that were without water service.

I am attaching for your reference the April and May reports DWSD submitted to the State Emergency Operations Center for the coronavirus pandemic. Governor Whitmer's Executive Order 2020-28 requires water suppliers to submit monthly reports regarding water restorations. These reports are responsive to your other questions. Please be assured we have translated all of our literature into Spanish, Arabic and Bengali languages.
