Don Johnson, 20501 Mark Twain and 19301 Wyoming president of 12th Precinct Community Relations, complained that bills mailed three to seven days prior to due date, using the United States postal service are recorded as late.

Michelle George, National Action Network, came before the board to thank the department for resolving the Channel 4 story about the running water issue. She

mentioned that on March 22, 2017 the Michigan Nurses Association marched in Lansing concerning the Patience Care Act and while there attended a forum on Blocks of Water and shut offs. Henry Ford Hospital did a study and found a correlation between water-related illnesses and water shut offs. Wants to know if the BOWC were aware of the study.

Fredia Butler, 8286 Normile, community activist, came before the board regarding late fees. She also came on behalf of Ms. Poles who received a \$600 water bill due to late fees.

Sallie Booker, 4305 W Euclid, came before the board regarding payment plan arrangements (PPA); she asked why the department does not allow a grace period.

Carman Booker, 19205 Orleans, came before the board regarding a water shut off.

Irina Puiu, 5881 Central Street, came before the board regarding water damage and \$9,000 water bill.

Robert Goodlet, 4571 Monteclair, came before the board regarding continuous flooding after every rainfall and why it takes so long for the department to vactor the drains.

Russell Bellant, former DWSD employee, came before the board to provide a copy of the DWSD wastewater collection system map. He said the sanitary overflow into the Rouge and Detroit River is not only from Detroiters.
