A. 20-0026 The Board of Water Commissioners for the City of Detroit, Water and Sewerage Department authorizes the Director to approve DWSD Amendment No. 2 to a contract with T & N Services for repair clamps; the amendment adds \$240,000 in funding for a total amended contract not-to-exceed amount of \$817,247, and extends the term for an additional 6 months and also authorizes the Director to take such other action as may be necessary to accomplish the intent of this vote.
