RE: Amendments to the By-Laws of the Board of Water Commissioners

Upon recommendation and opinion of Debra N. Pospiech, General Counsel, the Board of Water Commissioners for the City of Detroit Water and Sewerage Department hereby approves amendments to the following Articles and Sections of its by-laws: Article III, Sections 3 and 4; deleting Article VII Staffing; Article VIII, Sections 1 and 2 and correcting Section numbers; Article IX, Section 2; Article X, Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5; Article XII, deleting Sections 2, 3 and 4; Article XVI, Section 3 and adding Section 9; and Article XVII.

BACKGROUND AND JUSTIFICATION

The Board reviewed a separate memorandum dated April 25, 2022, outlining the rationale for various recommended amendments to by laws.
